Ryan Butler has been a Special Agent (SA) with the FBI since 2002. SA Butler is a licensed CPA and has worked in the FBI's San Francisco, Anchorage, and Seattle divisions where he has investigated a variety of matters including complex financial crimes and domestic terrorism. SA Butler was a case agent on a corporate fraud investigation that stemmed from McKesson-HBOC's restatement of earnings which resulted in a multi-billion dollar loss by shareholders. SA Butler was also a co-case agent on the attempted bombing during the 2011 Martin Luther King, Jr. Unity Parade in Spokane, Washington.
